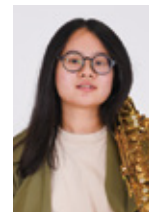
Through this experience, I realized the importance of having my own shooting style and preferences. Moving forward, I want to continue valuing and developing my originality and style.

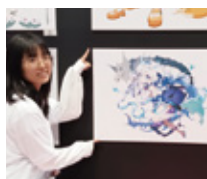
The audience that gathered at Roppongi Craps on the day of the event cheered for the students. The success of the event led to a request for the next performance on August 2, 2024.

It covered a wide range of topics, from the history of this genre to practical applications such as understanding electronic performance, how to start working in this field, how to transform studio-produced tracks into live stage performances, and creating live loops with Ableton Live for electronic performances.

Mr.Feng, a 2nd year student in the Berklee Study Abroad Course, shared his excitement: "It was an incredible event that expanded my perspective as a musician! In the workshop, I felt like I truly experienced the essence of music production, from real-world production techniques to exploring rhythm and harmony."

Jikei COM Group schools utilize the network of its sister schools in New York, Collective and Sound Collective, to offer online programs for music and teach students throughout the year. This is an opportunity for students to learn about the content of the NY schools while in Japan, and to cultivate a global mindset, including English, by learning about foreign ways of thinking and industry conditions.

Music Business Lecture is one of NY Online contents and it is an opportunity for students to learn about the music industry in general.

The students listened to the lectures, and then spent six days with Ron Thaler, a multi-Grammy award-winning, Billboard #1 music producer, drummer, and 360° sound entrepreneur, who gave a valuable lecture to the students.

After listening to the lectures, the students had a "student presentation" on the final day, in which they presented their own promotion plans based on the assignments given by Mr. Ron.

This time, we interviewed Mr. Teoh, an international student at TSM, who was very active in guiding and interpreting the presentations of the younger students. Mr. Teoh has experience playing and teaching drums in Malaysia, and he also raised funds to study in Japan through his activities as a drummer on the street.

In the future, he would like to use his knowledge of music and the languages he speaks (English, Chinese, Japanese, and Malay) to support musicians in their activities from behind the scenes.

He is currently a manager course's student at TSM.

「I think that the contents of Mr. Ron's class are very useful for my future work. I learned a lot. I was one of the presenters in the NY Program class last year.

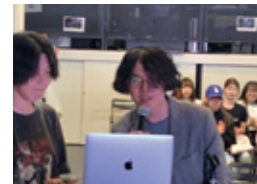

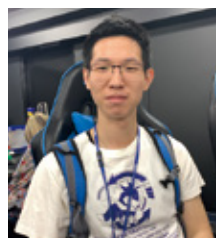
The students also provided guidance on script reading and character analysis, making it a very meaningful opportunity for international exchange!

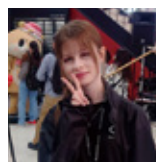

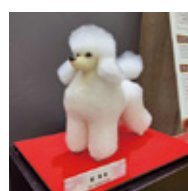
Looking back on my first year at the school

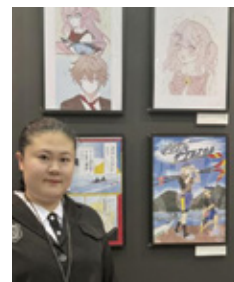
